If you're experiencing a life-threatening emergency within a company facility:



Using a Cisco phone, call 911, and then contact our Security Operations Center at ext. 2911. Using any other phone, call 911, then 845-577-2911.

To save these important instructions on the screen of your Cisco phone, go to:

- 1. Settings
- 2. User Preferences

4. Highlight Option 3

- 3. Background Images
- 5. Hit Select
 6. Save
 - 7. Exit, and Exit again
- It's important to contact our Security Operations Center (SOC) after calling 911 so that Security personnel can notify Fire Marshals and direct emergency responders to the right location without delay. If you download the *LiveSafe* app to your mobile phone, *LiveSafe* will save you the second call by automatically alerting the SOC of your emergency and location.

LiveSafe is not used as a tracking app. It only communicates your location when you have reached out for help during an emergency. Speak with your manager or supervisor if you have any questions about emergency reporting procedures.
